

How to Register Your Team

REGISTRATION INFORMATION. Schools may register as many teams as they wish in local tournaments; however, schools can only advance a maximum of two teams to the state championship tournament. The names of all teachers, attorney coaches and students on a team must be submitted on the Code of Ethical Conduct Team Roster to the regional and state tournament coordinators at the start of each tournament. Students must be involved in educational instruction at the high school level. Each team must have at least one teacher sponsor and one attorney coach. If the team is having difficulty finding an attorney coach, contact the CBA for assistance.

Complete and return the attached registration form with a check for a \$125 registration fee per team (if postmarked no later than December 1, 2009) or a \$200 registration fee per team (if postmarked December 2, 2009 through December 18, 2009). **Make your check payable to the Colorado Bar Association. Registration fees go towards program expenses. Mail to the Colorado Bar Association (Attention: Carolyn Gravit), 1900 Grant Street, Suite 900, Denver, CO 80203-4336. You can also pay by Visa or MasterCard.**

EARLY ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY DECEMBER 1, 2009
LATE ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN December 18, 2009

WAIVER OF FEES. Only early registration fees may be waived due to hardship. Submit a request to the CBA Mock Trial Subcommittee via the State Mock Trial Coordinator. Fee waiver requests must be received no later than December 1, 2009. Late registration fees will not be waived.
